Letter of Understanding and Commitment

Purpose:

To clarify for parents and athletes the expectations and commitment expectations of all players, parents, and coaches participating in Folsom Softball Club's Select softball program.

Program Philosophy

Folsom Softball Club's objectives for all programs are to provide a positive experience for each girl who participates and provide a high quality and character-driven program. The Select program allows players to experience how it feels to play at a competitive level, increasing skills and passion for the game. It is a difficult and time-consuming responsibility to be the parent of a softball player playing at a more competitive level. We all want what is best for our athletes. The league and coaching staff can promise you that they want your daughter to succeed. The staff will work as hard as possible to help her achieve her goals. Playing time and her role on the team are based on effort, skill, team play, practice habits, attitude, and performance. **Playing time is not guaranteed for any player.** Some players will not get as much playing time as other girls, and in some games, a player may not play at all. The goals of the team will always come before individual desires. The league and coaching staff believe there are many rewards that come from being part of a team. They include the improvement that comes from everyday effort, the friendships made, and the lessons learned. These benefits far outweigh the game time played. Success is earned through commitment and team play. Every girl will have a role on the team. No role is less important than another. The success of the team, and the success of your daughter as an individual, will be based on how well each player performs her specific role.

Player Responsibilities:

- Always work hard to improve softball skills and conditioning to make the team better as a whole.
- Perform with passion at the highest level, giving 100% in practice and games.
- Keep emotions under control - stay positive.
- Maintain the goals of the team above individual desires.



Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:

- Ensure that Select registration fees are paid in full no later than the deadlines announced. The registration fee through Team Sideline will include all base tournament fees and uniform fees divided by total players per team (does NOT include the additional cost for summer tournaments and Nationals).
- Remember that your team leadership is made up of volunteers who are parents just like you. Please be as patient, helpful, and responsive to requests as possible.
- Accept the decision of the officials. Please do not boo or heckle, regardless of your feelings.
- Refrain from name calling or using profane or disrespectful language when addressing players, coaches, other parents, and officials.
- Be encouraging to fellow parents and families.
- Be respectful and supportive to coaches at practices, games, and at home. It is important that a positive atmosphere is fostered at home about your daughter's role on the team.
- Always support your daughter (both good and bad).
- Adhere to all FSC, USA Softball, and applicable tournament rules.
- **Failure to adhere to these responsibilities can affect your daughters standing on the Select team.**

Commitment:

Playing on a Select team is a big commitment! The commitment begins in January and could extend through July. By signing this form, you are agreeing to be available for practices and all tournaments listed below in addition to the National Championships (must qualify). The goal of every Select team should be to qualify for Nationals. Attending Nationals will require additional funds and will extend the season through the full month of July.

The City of Folsom closes all softball fields during the months of November – February. It may be necessary for Select teams to practice in surrounding areas where field space is available, or at indoor facilities until Folsom locations open in March.

Please record your agreement to be available for each of the following commitments. If you know you cannot be available for a specific set of dates, please note that below. This could impact the coach's decision to select your daughter; however, if you do not note a conflict now and your daughter is unavailable later this could impact your standing with the current Select team or the ability to participate in the Select program in the future.

Cost to Play:

This is a per player estimate and can vary based on number of players and miscellaneous expenses.

- Spring 2025 Rec Registration \$225 (due in November)
- Base Tournament Fees \$220 - \$250 (due in January) *
- Spring Select Uniforms \$150 - \$175 (due in January) *
- Miscellaneous costs such as field/indoor facility rentals \$100 - \$125 (due in January) *
- Additional Summer Tournament Fees \$175 - \$250 (due in April/May) *
- Additional Summer Jersey/Socks (if needed) \$50 - \$75 (due in April/May) *

*** No refunds issued for fees paid as they are paid upfront per team by FSC.**



Guest Play:

Since Select players are very talented, your daughter may be asked to guest play on another team by a Competitive A Program Coach. This will impact your standing on the Select team. Players may not guest play, scrimmage, practice, workout, or tryout for A level teams without becoming ineligible to play at the Select level for the rest of the year.

Escalation Process

24-Hour Rule - "Cool Down": Please do not approach any member of the coaching staff for 24 hours after a game with any complaints. Preferred method of communication is email or phone call with your concerns or issues addressed to the head coach. The 24-hour period is designed to give you time to provide a more objective opinion about any issues and will aid in a more productive conversation with the coach. If a family is unhappy with the approach and decides to leave the team, there will be no hard feelings. This program may not suit every player or family.

If your issue is unable to be resolved with the coach, please reach out to the appropriate FSC Division Rep or Coach Agent. He or she will escalate as appropriate.
